As we are congregated in our camp just north of the Goff's Schoolhouse, we shall enjoy the traditional fellowship and entertainment a Holcomb Clamper has become accustomed to.

Additionally, you will have an opportunity to tour Goffs Schoolhouse and all its wonderments. For those brothers who arrive on Thursday, you may elect to participate on as 4x4 (Highway Vehicles Only) trek to some local sites. On Friday, you may take some time to witness the operation of some olden times mining equipment including a Stamp Mill.

This event is for Redshirts only, no guests or PBCs. The rub for this event is \$65 for current Hemi members and \$75 for first-time attendees. There will be a \$10 late fee if your gold dust is postmarked after March 1, 2026. Each Redshirt will receive a HEMI XXXIX t-shirt, a HEMI member badge for new HEMI redshirt and event hanger. Please include your shirt size. If you are a big boy as in 4XL or 5XL, make sure you get your shirts in BEFORE March 1, 2026, otherwise you will need to drop some pounds to fit in a 3XL. Each Clamper needs to bring food for all meals, water (dry camp), artificial shade, your favorite beverages, a full tank of gas for the trek, cooking and camping equipment, and an entry for the annual HEMI Cooking Contest on Saturday night. This contest will be judged by Cookie and his hand-picked group of highly discerning culinary experts. The contest award categories to be judged are: Greatest Libation (cocktail), Most Satisfactory Presentation, Most Delicious Entree, Best Dessert, Sensational Bribe, of did I mention Greatest Libation? Judging begins at 18:03 p.m. Trophies and raffles will be awarded at 20:07 p.m. Saturday night at the Clamp Store. Campfires are allowed in containers only above ground and you must haul away your ashes, that is: **PACK IT IN AND PACK IT OUT**. All of the usual no-no's apply: no fighting, no ground fires, guns, PBCs, widders, orphans, long knives, pets or dogs, fireworks or explosives, OHVs and dirt bikes, **NO** bad attitudes or unseemly behavior.

### Directions from west:

From Hwy 15, take interstate 40 east towards needles 107 miles to exit 107 rd 66 goffs road towards fenner. Take this road 10.7 miles, and turn north on Lanfair rd. Campsite is on the west side of road less than 1/2 mile from rd 66.

### Directions from east:

From interstate 40, exit 107/rd 66 and go north east on rd 66 for 10.7 miles, turn north on lanfair rd, and proceed less than 1/2 mile To clampsite on west side of road.
