Container Fires Only

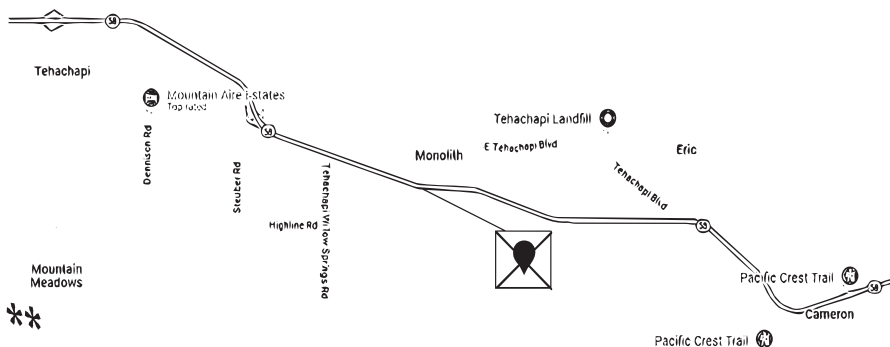
Camp Fire Containers must be elevated at least one foot from the ground. Do not burn or scorch the grass.
