Head Abbot Scott "Scootertrash" Wall invites all Redshirts to the annual Society of 4x4 Vituscan Missionaries Winter Ice Event to be held on January 17-20, 6024, south of Corona, California. Join us as we visit historic locations in and around Temescal Canyon, and an active clay mine that supplies pitcher's mound dirt for the New York Yankees. This area has had mining activity for 130 years. The price for this trip is \$55 for current Vituscans and \$65 for Redshirts who wish to become Vituscan Missionaries, pre-paid by December 28. \$10 more after 12/28 and at the door. Guests (male, over 18) may ride along for a fee of \$15 but will not receive any Vituscan goodies. Each Redshirt will receive a vest badge and/or event hanger, a history keepsake and the Vituscan goodie. There will be event hoodie sweatshirts on sale for this trip. You can order them pre-paid by the cut-off date. Hoodie zipper sweatshirts are: Med-2XLg \$25, 3XLg-5XLg are \$30. No promise of hoodies or goodies for late payments postmarked after December 28, 2018. Each person needs to bring food for all meals, your favorite beverages, all of your cooking and camping gear, artificial shade, a full tank of gas for the trip, and water (dry camp). Gas and supplies available within three miles of camp. Campfires are allowed in containers only. You must also haul away your ashes. Unkl Dave's Breakfast Burritos will be sold at check-in on Saturday for \$5 from 6:30-8am. No fighting, no widders, no orphans, no pets, no dogs, no explosives or fireworks, no O.H.V.s. Freeloaders and brawlers will be banned for life. There will be a Friday run which leaves camp at noon. To get there take your best route to Corona, Ca and go south on I-15 for 8.5 miles to Exit 88 at Temescal Valley Road. Turn left and go north on Temescal Valley Rd. for 0.6 of a mile to Dawson Canyon Rd. Turn right and continue to camp on the right. Watch for ECV signs. The Clampsite is open to all sizes of RVs & trailers. No hookups. Clampsite opens Thursday at 8am.
